Watery Eyes Watery eyes or increased tearing is another sign of an eye infection that people often mistake for allergies. Clogged tear ducts may cause watery eyes. Don't wipe those tears from your eyes with a tissue so you don't exacerbate the infection. Antibiotics can quickly stop this symptom in both adults and children.
